

Tatiana Loisha is a collaborative pianist and coach in the Greater Washington DC area. She has been collaborating with the Potomac Vocal Institute and actively performing in the area accompanying singers and instrumentalists since 2014 having moved to the US from Minsk, Belarus.

For three years, Tatiana lived in Cleveland, Ohio working as a staff accompanist at the Cleveland Institute of Music, Baldwin Wallace University, and as a rehearsal and performance pianist with the Cleveland Opera Theater, before moving back to the DC area.

Ms. Loisha has a BA in piano performances and a graduate degree in collaborative piano from the Belarusian State Academy of Music. She is a winner of the Shostakovich competition (Russia), International Competition for Young Pianists (France), and a winner of several contests for singers and pianists duets in Lithuania and Russia.

Tatiana has been successfully working with talented vocalists and accompanied at such world famous international competitions as Queen Elisabeth Competition, Operalia, BBC Cardiff Singer of the World, and Montreal International Musical Competition.
